


SSC CONCESSIONS

- Writer/Reader (of 9th grade of lower) for all subjects if mentioned in the certificate
- Additional 20 minutes for every hour for each subject/writer/reader
- 20% internal marks, condonation of spelling errors
- French is not taught in school the student will have to prepare for this subject on their own
- **Not offered in Std. IX
- Students will have to study regular subjects till they obtain the LD certificate

NIOS CONCESSIONS

- Registration is valid for 5 years. Students can appear for 2 or 3 subjects twice a year (i.e. April/October)
- Additional time of 1 hour for each subject OR provision of writer/reader if mentioned in the certificate

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED (FOR ADMISSION)

- Completely filled admission form
- Dependence Photocopy of birth certificate, aadhaar card, original school leaving certificate* and last marksheet
- □ Assessment reports (if any)
- □ Two recent passport size & stamp size coloured photographs (if seeking admission in Std X, five recent passport size coloured photographs and two stamp size coloured photographs)
- Medical history signed statement
 - *For Std X SSC, Std IX school leaving certificate dated on or before 30th June

NOTE

For students who have obtained an LD certificate from authorized centres - KEM, SION or NAIR hospital, concessions will be available as per the SSC & NIOS norms. Students appearing for Std. X board exams should be 14 years old on or before 31st July.
