- Completely filled admission form
- Photocopy of birth certificate, Aadhaar card, school leaving certificate* and latest mark sheet
- Assessment reports (if any)
- Two recent passport size & stamp size coloured photographs (if seeking admission in Grade 10, five recent passport size coloured photographs and two stamp size coloured photographs)
- Signed statement of medical history

*For SSC - HSC, Grade 9 school leaving certificate dated on or before 30 June

National Institute of Open Schooling, New Delhi (NIOS Grades 10 to 12)

JUNIOR SECTION (Grades 4 to 8)

- English

- Marathi (For Grade 8 students without Dyslexia)

SENIOR SECTION (Grades 9 & 10 - SSC) Private Candidates : Form 17

Students can appear for SSC after completing 14 years of age as of 31 July.

SSC Optional Subjects only for students with LD certificate from Nair, KEM, JJ Hospital or Sion Hospital only. Students will have to study regular subjects till they get their LD certificate from the authorized centres listed above.

- English (Compulsory)
- Hindi OR Decorative Pieces & Utilisation of Waste Material
- Science & Technology (I & II) OR Physiology, Health & Hygiene, Home Science
- Marathi OR Drawing & Painting
- Social Science (History & Political Science and Geography) (Compulsory)
- Mathematics (I & II) - Algebra & Geometry OR Arithmetic + Milk & Milk Products



GRADED SUBJECTS (SSC Grades 9 & 10)

- Water Security
- Physical Education (P.Ed)
- Defence Studies
- Information Technology (Only for Grade 9)

SSC Concessions: For students with LD certificate from Nair, Sion or KEM Hospital only.

- 20 minutes additional time per hour
- Provision for a writer/reader from 9 grade or lower, from any board for all subjects (only theory), 6th grade or lower for grade 7 Math (Arithmetic) if mentioned in the certificate. (Parents to arrange for writer)

Grades 11 & 12 HSC COMMERCE

- English (Compulsory)
- EVS (Compulsory) (Graded)
- Health & Physical Education (Compulsory)(Graded)
- Information Technology
- Organization of Commerce
- Book Keeping & Accountancy
- Secretarial Practice/Mathematics
- Economics



Subjects will be offered as per the center where the student is registered for HSC Board exam as a private candidate.



NIOS Grades 10 to 12

- English (Compulsory)
- Economics
- Painting
- Data Entry Operations
- Home Science

NIOS registration to be done by 15 March for exams in October and by 15 September for exams in April.

Registration for Grade 10, after completion of 14 years, is valid for 5 years

Registration for Grade 12, after completion of 15 years, is valid for 5 years.

Students can appear for all subjects after a minimum of 2 years of completing 10

Students can opt for staggered NIOS and appear for exams in chosen subjects twice a year (April & October)

NIOS Concessions: For students with LD certificate from Nair, KEM, JJ Hospital or Sion Hospital only.

Provision for a writer/reader (of grade 9 or lower of any board) & 20 minutes additional time per hour
